

## PROCUREMENT NOTICE

### HVT/015 – Preparation of a Business Case for HDM-4

The UK Department for International Development (DFID) has appointed IMC Worldwide Ltd (IMC) to establish a Programme Management Unit (PMU) with responsibility for the delivery of the High Volume Transport Applied Research Programme.

IMC invites Suppliers to submit a proposal to provide services in accordance with the Terms of Reference for assignment HVT/015 under the High Volume Transport Programme.

The primary objective of this assignment is to produce a bankable Business Plan for the future of the HDM-4 software. In carrying out this objective the study should explore all possible options for putting the ownership, management and maintenance of this product on a more sustainable and commercial basis.

This procurement is open to all eligible Suppliers in accordance with the provisions of the Request for Proposal and will be conducted on a competitive basis.

The closing date for submission of proposals is **12<sup>th</sup> May 2019 at 17.00pm BST**. The expected date for the commencement of the Services is approximately 1<sup>st</sup> July 2019.

Selection of a Supplier will be on the basis of a combination of the technical and financial scores achieved following a **4-stage process**. The technical points score will receive an 80% weighting and the financial points score a 20% weighting. A minimum technical score of 75 points will be required to ensure further consideration of the proposal.
